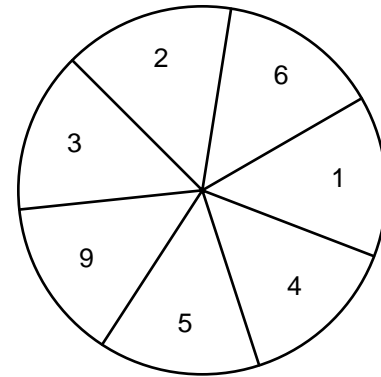

What is the lowest?

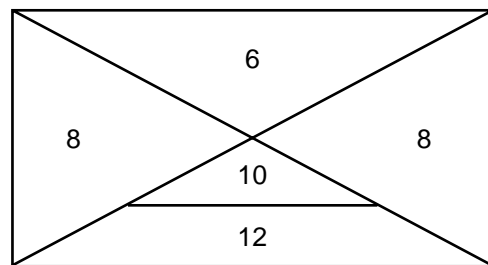
Write number sentences that show your answer.
